We recommend public transport or bike.

- **Metro:** Kursalon can be reached by using the metro line **U4** (station "Stadtpark", exit Johannesgasse) including few meters walk or the metro line **U3** (station "Stubentor", exit Parkring) and about 50 meters walk
- **Train (S-Bahn):** You can also access Kursalon by using the S-Bahn (station "Landstrasse Wien Mitte) & walk about 200 meters
- Trams: The tram lines 2 (station "Weihburggasse", few meters walk), 71 or D (both station "Schwarzenbergplatz", about 50 meters walk) will also get you to Kursalon quickly
